The month of June came to an end and we did not have much to report from the IRC. But there were a few items that needed to be addressed.

Our brothers and sisters were having a situation in Greece and we had a IRC committee member ask me to chime in. I saw a few violations of the guidance code and brought it to their attention, one was using non-GA literature. I explained to them that their translation of our literature must be approved by the BOT and pointed it the procedure in the guidance code. They are having a vote so I could submit it as an agenda item for San Diego.

Next we have two other languages that are waiting for approval of translation from the BOT. They are German and Latvian. Hoping we can meet at the BOT sooner than later. One good news was all the groups in Latvia have opened for face to face meetings.

One last thing is the contact from Iran has contacted me again asking for translated literature. I explained the process to him and asked him to get a group started and we will be able to assist him.

I did not have much to ask my committee to address since I did not get many inquires from the ISO.

See what July will bring.
