The following is what the IRC was busy with for September. We did get some inquiries about starting groups or maybe finding help from Iran, China and Thailand. We did help a group commence in Nicaragua, we have shipped out a new group packet and they are getting good participation.

We helped groups in Latvia, Mexico and Hungary find ways to donate to the ISO thru wire transfers etc.

We were contacted by two different groups in France where they have already begun meeting, we are in the process of getting them recognized and listed on ISO website.

I was able to help Latvia set up their intergroup and invited them to listen in on our intergroup meeting by phone. It is a phone meeting due to covid. They had many questions which I was able to help with my experience strength and hope.

I was also contacted by a brother from Lithuania asking questions about our rules and procedures, I referred them to the guidance code to find most answers. Other questions were about trustees and translation of our literature.

Finally, I was in contact with our sisters in Argentina who were having issues with printing GA approved literature and reaching their RSO. We were able to get them a temporary understanding of local printing of GA approved literature. They were very grateful.

It was a busy month and we will continue to serve our fellowship where needed.
