

Trustee Website Committee Report June 2016

The biggest change for the Trustee website is the listing and display of the monthly ISO Life-Line Bulletin. This is a temporary situation until the ISO website is reconfigured to allow for the addition of the Bulletin. Since the new BOR officers will take their positions come July 1, the committee will be pressing for a timeline for when this conversion will take place. Positioning the Bulletin on the Trustee website was conditioned on this being a temporary situation.

The mobile app for GA meeting locations is still not complete. The app must be tweaked for some changes and modifications that are not working on a universal basis. Hopefully, this will take place in the month of July. This app will be available for the iOS and Android platforms.

Additionally, the ISO must complete author license applications for both platforms and pay the filing fees. This will allow the ISO to load the apps to their respective platforms. The app will be free to all and only cover rooms in the United States, in its initial rollout. The money for this process has been allocated previously for \$4,000 and half has been paid up to now. The balance will be paid upon completion of the project.

Website analytics have been uploaded to a number of pages on the website to help determine usage of the various features of the site. As per the discussion and committee report in Phoenix, the committee is considering deleting features that are not being utilized by the Trustees and membership alike. Such decisions will probably be made before the San Diego conference.

As committee chair, I am personally please to announce that Donna K, from Area 7, has volunteered to join the committee and work with the programming that is critical to the constant maintenance and update of the site.

A Trustee Transition Roster Link has been loaded to help the ISO with information as to which Trustees will be returning or not, and which new Trustees have been elected for the new 2-year term.
