## Trustee Website Committee Report June 2017

Information from the Cherry Hill Trustee meeting, has not been updated on the Trustee website, because the minutes of the Trustee meeting are considered as unofficial until 30 days after the minutes are released. The minutes will be considered official on July first. All decisions will be updated in all publications after that.

No new features have been suggested to the Trustee Website Committee. However, 2 have 2 new members to the committee, as of Cherry Hill. We welcome, Mike R. from area 6A and Steve P. from area 6B. Both of them bring website programming and development experience with them. It is our hope that the committee can come up with a new website design that will enable more functionality and security. We will be looking at the WordPress platform to build a new site to be approved by the Board of Trustees.

The focus on the new site, will be to allow automatic notification to those members who wish to know when specific parts of the website are updated. Currently, the site is passive. If the members don't go to the site on their own, they will be unaware of changes that may occur. The idea of an entitlement-based site, allows the member to select various notification levels. We are hopeful that our 2 new members will be able to make such features available in the new website.

Money was approved to pay for the formal programming to the current ISO website to accept credit/debit card contributions of all sorts. The Board of Regents will have to approve the procedure to be fully compliant with Unity Step 7. This new segment will involve a different credit card processing company that will transfer the credit card discount and clearance fees to the user. The process of structuring a contribution module for the ISO website will be completed before Ontario, but formal implementation to the site may not be done by then.
